

Foods Dangerous to Your Pets



The following foods may be dangerous for your Pet to eat. Show your parents this list and be sure to never feed your Pets any of the foods from this list. Pets do best when they stay away from people food and eat commercial brand Pet foods designed especially for them.

- Ø Alcoholic beverages
- Ø Apple seeds
- Ø Apricot pits
- Ø Avocados—toxic to birds, mice, rabbits, horses, cattle and dairy goats
- Ø Cherry pits
- Ø Candy (particularly chocolate, which is toxic to dogs, cats and ferrets, and any candy containing the sweetener Xylitol)
- Ø Coffee (grounds, beans, chocolate covered espresso beans)
- Ø Grapes
- Ø Macadamia nuts
- Ø Moldy foods
- Ø Mushroom plants
- Ø Mustard seeds
- Ø Onions and onion powder
- Ø Peach pits
- Ø Potato leaves and stems (green parts)
- Ø Raisins
- Ø Rhubarb leaves
- Ø Salt
- Ø Tea (caffeine)
- Ø Tomato leaves and stems (green parts)
- Ø Walnuts
- Ø Yeast dough
